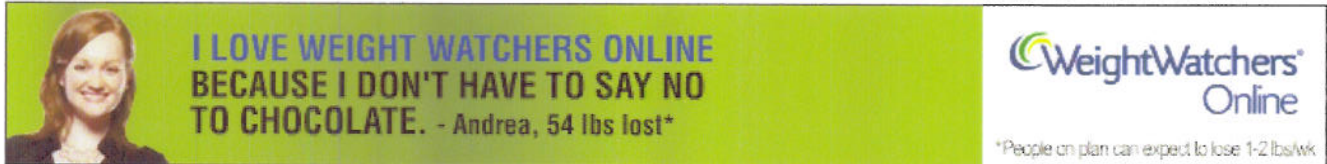

Spicy Pickle Special Sandwich to Benefit Houston Food Bank
